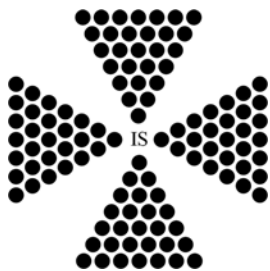

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SPOT ON

The Winter Olympics has just completed. Although I am not a sports fan, the small amount of this year's event that I watched, as always, inspired me. I am impressed by the tremendous dedication and sheer hard work of the individuals and nations to train the physical, emotional and mental bodies to break through previous records of speed, distance and other physical challenges.

And, when I saw the five inter-connected red circles of the Olympics, I thought of the usually unheralded spiritual Olympics that individuals and Humanity have always engaged in. There are five initiations which perfect the human being and reveal him/her as a living soul. Each one pits the individual against his self-imposed limitations. Each one requires relentless hard work over many lives.

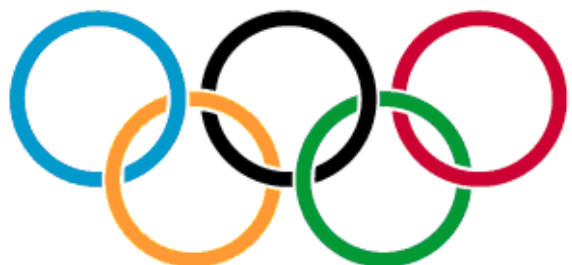

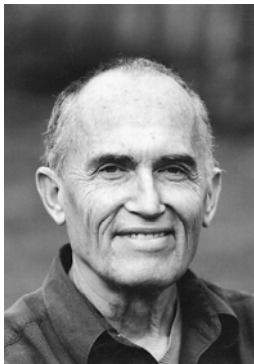

SILENCE

At the time of the Full Moons and at the time of the Spiritual Festivals, silence seems to beckon. It seems close, mysterious, appealing and behind a veil of sound. Yet, it is always elusive, just out of reach and, sometimes, almost contacted.

As a child, I remember lying on the grass on a summer's night and looking up at the stars. There was no sound. But, there was a deep sense of peace as if the door to a hidden place was about to open. There was no wind and all was still. Then, a bee buzzed by and the sound was vivid; its edges electric. It made me aware of the absence of sound; the previous state of silence.

If silence is somewhere close by, but, never really present, sounds are everywhere. Inside, there are the constant conversations in my mind and the gurgling, creeks and thumps of the body. Outside, there are the million sounds of the world: the ticking clocks, radios, televisions, cars, planes, computers, people, lawnmowers, power lines, animals, insects, wind and rain. All of creation makes itself known in sound.

I have always found the absence of sound appealing. I have turned off the music, turned off the mechanical device and walked away from an environment teeming with sound. Something is present when sound is not.

I have actively pursued silence. I have travelled to the mountains, spent time alone, and pulled free from mechanical sounds. I have gone inward in meditation and contemplation. And, occasionally, been unaware of sound. Yet, I can not say that I have known silence.

Several years ago, as a part of a group founding a school of meditation, we designed and built a meditation temple in a quiet place on the lip of an ancient volcano. We named it the Silent Space because we perceived it as a place to approach silence. One of the first things that I noticed when sitting in the temple was that the wind, as it blew across the top of the roof, created sound. I felt disappointed.

Over the years of meditating in this space, however, I have noticed that there is a quality in the space that I associate with silence. There is a

pregnant emptiness; a potent potentiality. I feel that often I approach silence when I spend time there. And, that these approaches give me an increasing desire for silence and sensitivity to its closeness.

Talking about silence seems similar to talking about God. Just as God is the no-thing. Silence is the no-sound. Both pervade all that is. Neither can be defined and thereby limited. Both are the creator and the power within creation.

When I cultivate silence, I create a detached response to sound and to the workings of my mind. Sound is/thoughts are much the same as water flowing by: I am aware of them, but do not hold to them. After a while, I enter a space where neither sounds nor thoughts are. It is a space without limits and time does not measure it.

When I exit this space, sound again appears. But, if I am in an environment with few sounds and I continue to cultivate detachment, I become aware of sounds or thoughts which I was previously unaware of. They seem to have emerged from the silence or been created by my approach to silence. They are potent, new, creative and responsive to a greater need.

I believe that the work to build the antahkarana or rainbow bridge is an occult bridge to silence. The Tibetan teachers call this same work the Kalachakra. Whether one uses the technique of the West or the East, the practice leads us into vibrational domains where the sounds and forms become more and more subtle as we approach the formless.

As we approach silence, we approach power and purpose. We approach a great constructive/destructive force. Only fools or Great Ones do it quickly. Silence offers liberation, but bridges must be built before they are destroyed.

Silence is at the centre of all things whether they be atoms, chakras or galaxies. Thinking of it this way, I like to think that I/we are silence. That we are like a great invisible bell sounding a soundless sound. Lives are spent attuning to the sound of silence.

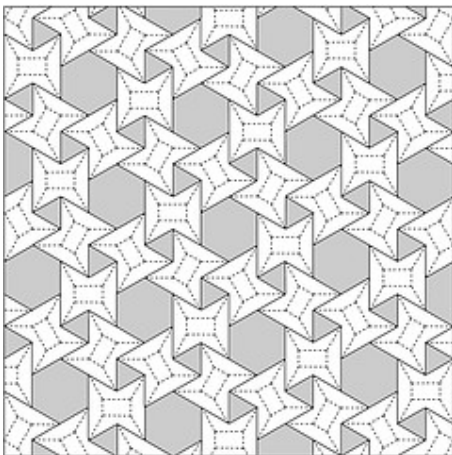
TESSELLATION, TILES AND THE ETHERIC WEB

Steven Schwartzman's The Words of Mathematics (1994, The Mathematical Association of America) says:

tessellate (verb), **tessellation** (noun): from Latin *tessera* "a square tablet" or "a die used for gambling." Latin *tessera* may have been borrowed from Greek *tessares*, meaning "four," since a square tile has four sides. The diminutive of *tessera* was *tessella*, a small, square piece of stone or a cubical tile used in mosaics. Since a mosaic extends over a given area without leaving any region uncovered, the geometric meaning of the word tessellate is "to cover the plane with a pattern in such a way as to leave no region uncovered." By extension, space or hyperspace may also be tessellated.

I believe tessellation is a crucial concept strongly related to the creative process. This link to creativity is via the word "lattice" or "web". The Play of Consciousness in The Web of the Universe by Edward L. Gardner develops some of the concepts outlined in The Secret Doctrine (H.P. Blavatsky). Gardner died in 1969 and his book was re-published in 1985. Since it's writing (1934/35), many articles have been written which substantiate his ideas.

In a tessellation, shapes may align (touch) or they may intersect so that one element is a part of different shapes. A good example of this type is the "Flower of Life" Pattern created by interlinking circles.

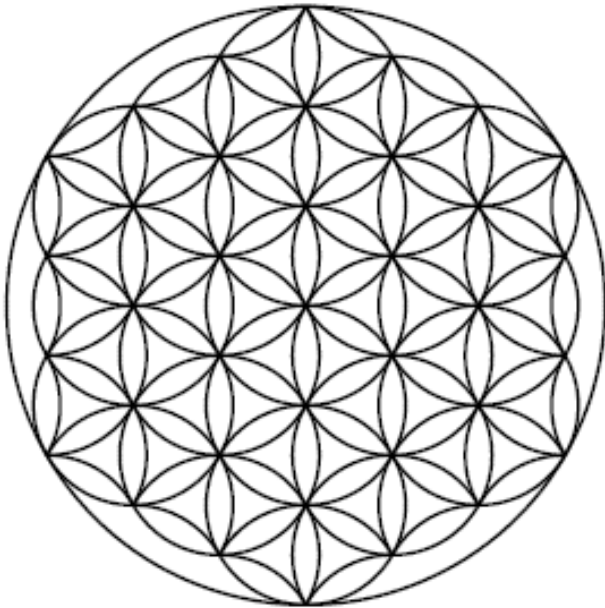
A bit like a held paradigm, a tessellation functions according to set parameters as the known elements seamlessly access the design. A new tessellation is designed to accommodate differing shapes or forms. Systems of mathematics have been developed to do this integrative work.

Tessellations have a variety of axes for modification of the dominant design, with the subsequent secondary shape filling the remaining space. The saturation response involves the perceiver maintaining a focus on the dominant shape until the interface or secondary design asserts its presence. This process of attention followed by saturation to the point of satiation creates a shift (or release) to an alternative point of focus (the secondary design). Complementarity both in colour and shape create the rhythm of pulsation that helps entrain the viewer to the fundamental wholeness of this field of interweaving. This pulsation is between the dominant and subdominant shape asserting their visual presence. An "off" and "on" mechanism is associated with this phenomena. Polarity may be associated with this process and reciprocity. A resultant state of consciousness may also be enfolded (enmeshed) within this rhythmic field. Australian Aboriginal bark painting evidences these phenomena, as does optical art (Brigitte Riley).

The tessellations created by Escher, and those found on mosque walls are essentially two-dimensional. These suggest planes or fields of unified activity. Three-dimensional tessellations may be envisioned by utilising the

platonic solids and creating an interlocking complex of quite massive proportions.

Crystalline structuring within the mineral domain evidences this process. Within the domain of matter (biological) Robert Williams in “The Geometrical Foundation of Natural Structure” attempts the development of a Form Language useful for the artist, scientist or architect.



Flower of Life

The “Flower of Life” tessellation based on the circle and extended to the sphere is foundational in that intersection points or nodes have been utilised to construct the platonic solids. While “Occult Chemistry” (Lead beater and Bezant) provides evidence that these structures are the building forms for inner creative work; Williams writing arose while he was a member of a small group of scientists investigating general structure.

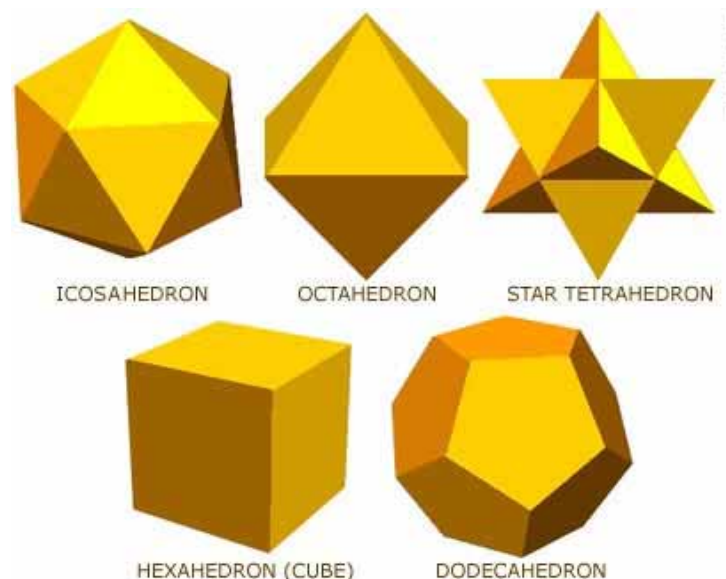
My interest is aroused when the chakra system is defined in terms of the nodal point where many lines intersect. Also they may be considered in relation to the flower of life as petal formations. Also a chakra within one system may be considered as an element within a greater patterning?

My “tessellation” fixation extends into the mental thought-form building domain. Language may be considered as an intricate

tessellation co-measurement where expression (possibly symbols) fits with the quest for meaning and understanding. Even telepathy may be related to this “tessellation” with a question being a defined configuration, a formulated vacuum or shaped negative space. This calls forth from nature, which abhors a vacuum, an answering positive configuration. The answer!

Returning to the basic shapes of geometry that are foundational to tessellation structuring, the idea dawns upon me that each shape has inherent qualities. A square has four sides, it has opposite sides and right angles and it evokes a boxed-in sensation. Associated with these qualities or properties are energies that may have an emotional or mental orientation. The resultant tessellation based on specific shapes or forms may also convey specific energetic keys. As the mind identifies and amplifies our interaction, language identifies the structure or energy matrix and names it.

This article may be continued and developed. I would appreciate any feedback. As I am not mathematically or scientifically inclined, I limit my discussion to occasional references to those areas. My interest is to understand at a comprehensive/inclusive level the underlying principles behind Life.



Platonic Solids

THE ONLY CONSTANT IS CHANGE

Ever since 3 November 2008, Saturn has been in opposition to Uranus. This opposition was or will be exact on 3/11/08, 5/2/09, 15/9/09, 27/4/10 and 26/7/10. The last time that this opposition occurred was during the cultural revolution of 1965. Saturn represents accepted limitations, stability and the status quo. Uranus represents revolution, change or chaos. It is as if reality and truth face off at the OK Corral.

When the cycle began, it seemed that Uranus had the upper hand. The world economic system seemed ready to go to hell in a handbag; the capitalist system was exposed as deeply flawed. (The bright ray of hope was that Obama was elected US president and promised "real change"). At the next two oppositions in 2009, it seemed that Saturn had the upper hand. The old system was buoyed up by massive amounts of money being transferred from the People's Purse to the very rich and most people were encouraged to nurse their fear of change.

The forces of reality, or no change, have been backed by a Saturn square to Pluto. The first exact square was 6/12/09, the second was 1/2/10 and the final one will be 21/8/10. (A similar transit of Saturn in opposition to Pluto last occurred in 1965). The effect of the transit is to cause deep fears to emerge, which can be healing and cathartic, or they can fester and cause a destructive conservative backlash.

Saturn was also backed by a retrograde Mars from 20 December to 10 March. A retrograde Mars slows change by encouraging everyone to double back and think about actions and plans which have previously been initiated. Now that that is over, change has more chance. Hopefully, we have used this period to refine our plans for progress.

On 23 May, Jupiter weighs into the struggle for change by opposing Saturn. This will occur again on 18 August and finally end with an

opposition on 29 March 2011. Such an event occurs every twenty years. Jupiter represents expansion, optimism and liberality. Like Uranus, it attempts to move the status quo towards change and growth. A new vision opposes the old order.

The forces of positive change will up the ante on 8 June when Jupiter and Uranus, the two change agents move into conjunction. (The event concludes on 4/1/11 with a final conjunction). This occurs every 14 years and this time occurs in the sign of compassion and redemption. This conjunction is associated with sudden insights or strokes of good fortune.

What will the final two oppositions of Saturn and Uranus in April and July produce? I suspect, not much, in April. But, at the time of the last Saturn/Uranus opposition in July, there will be tremendous polarization. The square of Saturn and Pluto will then be in opposition to not only Uranus, but also Jupiter. Saturn and Uranus will be ruling their respective signs at the highest (monadic) level. Something will have to give.

The promise of a positive change seems to rest on the Jupiter conjunction of Uranus that takes us to the end of the year. But, there is no happy ending in sight. We individually and collectively must face our deepest fears and change.



TIGER WOODS PROFILE

I remember seeing an interview of Tiger Woods. I was captivated by his palpable will. Here was an incredibly focused, intelligent and powerful individual. My sense was that he had the ability to do great things in the world and he could accomplish just about anything he set his mind to. His consciousness was high.

I also saw a movie about his life which chronicled his entree into golf, the mentoring and strong bond he had with his father, and his life growing up. His mother took him to see a Buddhist monk who told her he had the 'Power of the Elephant' and could do great things in the world. His father relentlessly trained him to believe in himself and to train his mind from a young age.

Numerologically Tiger is a 1. He is a strong individual, a born leader, and who wants to be number 1. They often struggle with loneliness and tend towards isolation, but are born to lead. His birth name equates to 9. This is the opposite to 1, this is the humanitarian, the one who sacrifices and teaches their wisdom and shares with the world. Often the birth number indicates the essential characteristics of a person and the name indicates what they will do with it.

When the scandal broke about his infidelity I looked at his astrology chart and saw that Saturn is transiting his 1st house. This

indicates an identity crisis. One begins to question who one is and where one is going. Life can throw up all sorts of challenges which are a test of one's identity.

I then looked at the return chart. This shows the themes that are predominant in the year from one birthday to the next. The chart shows challenges again in the 1st house of identity. The Sun, Venus and Pluto are all focussed there. Plus all are squaring Saturn in the 10th house. The sun being in the 1st house indicates a focus on one's image, identity etc, this is a year focussed on Tiger the man. Venus in the 1st house plus conjunct the sun indicates relationships and money are highlighted on a mundane level and the soul is highlighted on a higher level. Pluto being in the 1st house indicates a transformation of one's image or one's identity. Things are brought to the surface. Pluto is also about power, so can expose abuses of power.

All three are squared by Saturn indicating a test imposed on his personality, his relationships or around money. These have been evident by the public exposure of his infidelity and subsequent withdrawal of sponsorship by several products he is an advocate for. Saturn is in the 10th house, the house of career and/or being in the public eye. Clearly his career has taken a huge battering and he has fallen far from grace in the eye of the public.

Mars is opposite Chiron which indicates a highlighting of wounds around the ego, and opportunities to heal those wounds. He is ostensibly undergoing treatment for his transgressions and has the potential to heal the wounds that drove him to step out of integrity. The moon is trine a stellium of Chiron, Neptune and Jupiter, which indicates he will be able to learn from and heal the wounds that have been exposed through this and that he has projected on to others.



Infidelity is a well-known and unfortunate phenomena of the modern world we live in, and no doubt it would be harrowing enough to have such an experience occur in one's personal life. However being such a public figure and such a role model, particularly for African American and Asian children, it is a world-wide humiliation where his actions have been exposed for the world to see and to disappoint millions of people around the globe, not to mention his wife and children.

On the other hand from a soul perspective his consciousness has been able to withstand such a global humiliation. As he said in his public apology, he thought he was entitled to the

advantages that came with fame and money, which he now realises was wrong.

Infidelity is no stranger to men of power with countless examples of indiscretions from some of the leading men of the 20th century – JFK, Martin Luther King, Ghandi, people who have done some amazing things in the world.

Tiger is 34 years of age and in the scheme of things at an age where the ego is naturally strong. However as the ageless wisdom teachings state, that around the age of 35 is when the soul takes hold and therefore anything that needs to be brought into balance will be.

So from a soul perspective Tiger has been presented with a great opportunity to step onto the path and follow a life of service. It is a possibility he is an initiate of some degree. He has started with the Tiger Woods Foundation which helps millions of children have access to education. With his status and his wealth he could do many more things on the world stage.

His infidelity does not diminish what he has put into effect in the lines of service, nor does it excuse his behaviour. Life is generally a mix of positive and negative and I think one of the most important things is to be realistic about ourselves and strive to integrate and overcome one's weaknesses, as well as not let the ego run away with our strengths, then one can be controlled by neither.
